## WESTERN CANADIAN DELEGATE PROCESS

### Step One

#### General Application

Must include: resume; motivation video (90 seconds) or motivation letter; one reference letter; 500 word essay on the 2019 topic; copy of recent academic transcript; copy of passport valid through November 2019

### Step Two

#### Shortlisted Candidates

Applications are due by January 6th

Applications must be submitted to [guestservices@thehangarmuseum.ca](mailto:guestservices@thehangarmuseum.ca)

Panel interviews will take place shortly after this deadline

### Step Three

#### Selection and Announcement

Selected candidate is contacted

Formal announcement is made

Candidate information is sent to FISE: United Space School for approval

### Step Four

#### Preliminary Assignments

All global delegates complete preliminary assignments remotely to ensure level competency

These assignments usually take place from April-June

---

### Step Five

#### United Space School

Attend the program in Houston, Texas

2019 program dates are July 21-August 5

### Step Six

#### Be a Program Ambassador

We expect alumni of this program to continue being ambassadors for the program including: helping to recruit and spread the message for future years; update our Museum membership about their experience; participate in press events for the program

### REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY:

Candidates must be enrolled in an accredited high school and be between 15 years of age and 19 years of age on July 23, 2019.

Candidates must be a Canadian citizen. The FISE: United Space School takes applications directly if you live in a country in which you do not hold citizenship.

Candidates should exhibit attributes of: academic excellence, teamwork skills, leadership within the community, public speaking, enthusiasm and multiculturalism.
